

LESSON 8: Basic Islamic Beliefs

1. Belief in Allah

- **Meaning:** Belief in the oneness of Allah, the Creator of everything.
- **Example:** Understanding that Allah is always watching over us and guiding us.

2. Belief in the Angels

- **Meaning:** Belief in the existence of angels who carry out Allah's commands.
- **Example:** Knowing that angels record our good and bad deeds.

3. Belief in the Prophets

- **Meaning:** Belief in all the Prophets sent by Allah, from Adam to Muhammad (PBUH).
- **Example:** Learning about the lives and teachings of the Prophets.

4. Belief in the Holy Books

- **Meaning:** Belief in the divine books revealed by Allah, including the Quran.
- **Example:** Reading and understanding the Quran and its teachings.

5. Belief in the Day of Judgment

- **Meaning:** Belief that all people will be judged by Allah for their deeds.
- **Example:** Understanding that our actions have consequences and striving to do good.

6. Belief in Qadar (Divine Decree)

- **Meaning:** Belief that everything happens by the will and decree of Allah.
- **Example:** Trusting Allah's plan and accepting that He knows what is best for us.
